Part Shade Kit

Part-shade areas of the yard are those that receive around 4-6 hours per day, not quite enough to get great blooms out of prairie plants, but a bit much for full-shade woodland species. These are for an area of roughly 45 sq. ft planted on 18-inch centers. Substitutions may be necessary from time to time. Substitutes are chosen based on site suitability as well as general aesthetic and bloom time. Kit includes:

- · Three Bottlebrush Grass
- · Two Big Leaf Aster
- · Three Sneezeweed
- · Two Tall Thimbleweed
- · Three Savanna Blazing Star
- Three Foxglove Beardtongue
- Two Culver's Root



Woodland Kit

Adding color to shaded areas of the garden (areas that receive less than 4 hours of sun per day). We include the following species depending on availability. Substitutions may be necessary from time to time. Substitutes are chosen based on site suitability as well as general aesthetic and bloom time. Kit includes:

Rain Garden Kit

Increases in spring rains and associated flooding and drainage problems have made rain gardens very popular. They reduce stormwater runoff while providing habitat for pollinators and birds. The flowers in this kit will start opening in late spring and bloom well into late summer. It will cover an area roughly 45 sq. ft and can tolerate standing water for over a week. We recommend that you plant these 14 to 18 inches on center when the soil is moist. Substitutions may be necessary from time to time. Substitutes are chosen based on site suitability as well as general aesthetic. We include the following species depending on availability:

- · Three Brown Fox Sedge
- · Three Cardinal Flower
- · Three Blue Flag Iris
- · Three Swamp Rose Mallow
- Two Monkey Flower
- Two Swamp Milkweed
- Two Marsh Blazing Star



Butterfly & Pollinator Kit

Our beginner pollinator kit offers gardeners an opportunity to add a key species to host and feed critically important pollinators and spread native plants. Plants also can be used for garden flowers as they will bloom for most of the summer and into the fall. Substitutions may be necessary from time to time. Substitutes are chosen based on site suitability as well as general aesthetic and bloom time. Of course, we also keep the pollinators in mind! We include the following species depending on availability:
